Beginner's Guide:

The Southeastern Catalog, which includes information regarding both Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary and the College at Southeastern, is fully online and has been since the Fall '13.

The current catalog is searchable and navigable using the navigation tools on the left side of the screen.

If you are looking for basic information about the school, then the "About Southeastern" page is a good place to begin, since it contains a great deal of useful information about the institution, our beliefs, and its history.

For information about our faculty and administrative leadership, see the "Leadership" link.

Those wondering how to become a student will do well to look under "Becoming a Student" link, which provides tuition information, information about the campus, and admissions policies.

Grading policies, transfer information and other critical academic policies are found under the "Academic Policies" link.

Specific degree program information, including a list of all programs offered, can be found in the Undergraduate, Graduate, Advanced Degree Programs, and Diplomas and Certificates. This includes an up to date list and description of majors, minors, and other degree options for each level of degree. (Note that the Master of Arts in Intercultural Studies is found under the College. The ThM is an Advanced Degree.)

Looking for information about courses in our catalog? See the Course Descriptions. This is a list filterable, so unless you know what you are looking for, it might be helpful to get at this information through the specific degree program you are interested in. Undergraduate courses are 1000's–4000's. Graduate level courses are numbered in the 5000's to 7000's. Advanced courses are in the 8000's–9000's.

Finally, for those who started prior to the current semester, your degree program can be found under the "Archived Catalog" list, where electronic copies of every catalog since Academic Year 2008–2009 are found. For earlier catalogs, please contact the Registrar's Office (registrar@sebts.edu).

What if I started under a previous catalog?

The Southeastern Catalog, which includes information regarding both Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary and the College at Southeastern, is fully online and has been since the Fall '13. As such, the default catalog should always be the catalog currently in effect. This means that if you matriculated prior to the current semester, you may need to access your degree program under the catalog for the semester you began your studies.

In other words, if you entered the school in the Bachelor of Arts, with a Major in Christian Studies in the Fall of 2013, you will need to look for your actual degree program in Academic Catalog 2013–2014. The current catalog may not reflect your current degree program.

Also, since the catalog has been online in the format, the institution has issued semi-annual updates. Therefore, Spring '14 and following matriculations are covered under the "Spring Update" of the appropriate catalog.

Your degree plan in Self-Service should always reflect your actual degree program, if you have questions.

Note that the school will honor the degree program you matriculated under. However, if there have been changes made to your benefit, you may change to the current catalog (only) by contacting the Registrar's office. This will necessarily be a wholesale change and not a partial change. (In other words, one may not select only those changes which are beneficial.)

Students that were academically inactive for four terms or more (including Summer and January) are required to reapply. They will be admitted and matriculated under the catalog in effect at that time.
